We have a letter from our Department Commander, Tammy Johnson on the latest "Legislative Conference" held in Washington D.C., 6-8 March 2023.

Comrades.

The Winter Legislative Conference was conducted 6-8 March. Your team consisted of Scott Gedling (National Representative), Eric Dudash (+1 requested by National), Danny Sample (Sr Vice Commander), Matthew Lambert (Adjutant/Quartermaster), Nancy Rathburn (Auxiliary President), Kay Gedling (Auxiliary Member), and Tammy Sample (Auxiliary Member).

This Conference was the first one of 118th Congress.

During 117th Congress, we played an instrumental role in getting over 300 co-sponsors for the Richard Star Act (please see attached talking points). Once a bill achieves 290 co-sponsors in the House, it is placed on the Caucus Calendar which means it can be brought to the floor for a vote. While the bill was placed on the Calendar, it never made it to the floor for a vote.

When a new Congress convenes, everything resets. Bills have to be reintroduced (now you know where "An act of Congress" comes from). S. 344 (Senate Bill) was reintroduced 2 February 2023 and H.R. 1282 (House Bill) was reintroduced on 3 March 2023.

In the 117th Congress neither of our Senators were cosponsors for S. 344. Since then, Senator Shelby retired and was replaced by Senator Britt. As of today, neither Senator Tuberville or Senator Britt have cosponsored the bill.

In the 117th Congress, three Representatives cosponsored H.R. 1282: Congresswoman Sewell, Congressman Moore, and Congressman Carl. Congressman Strong is the only freshman for Alabama in the 118th Congress; he replaced Congressman Brooks. As of today, the original three are the only cosponsors for H.R. 1282.

Another talking point was "Conference was Cracking Down on Predatory Claims Companies" via H.R. 1139. This piece of legislation will protect veterans from being overcharged (there is a maximum percentage that can be charged by certified by the VA) as well as from participating in fraud, guided by these predatory companies. As of today, Congressman Carl is the only cosponsor for Alabama. There is no Senate Bill to date for the 118th Congress.

We spoke on Economic Opportunity's Role in Preventing Suicide. As of now, the VA only looks at suicide within the medical realm. Many factors play a role in suicides. We are asking Congress to have the VA include all of the VA benefits that veterans participate in to be included in data for the prevention of suicide. New legislation has just been introduced; however, I do not have the number yet. I will follow up and report back.



A last-minute addition to our Talking Points was to advocate for the Expeditionary Medal to be awarded to those service members serving to support NATO operations. This would directly affect Reservists and National Guardsmen and Guardswomen. In many instances service members are serving in a "training" capacity and not in a "deployed" status. This prevents the service member from obtaining benefits. Serving as support for NATO often times is dangerous and beyond "training." There is no legislation at this time.

With all of these points we pointed out that not only do these points affect veterans and service members, but it also directly affects families.

Comrades, your voice matters. Please contact your elected representatives (they represent YOU) and tell them they need to take care of the veterans, service members, and their families. When you do, please send me a copy of your written correspondence or CC me on electronic correspondence.

If you haven't already, sign up for Action Corps, the link is provided. ANYONE can sign up, so please share the link with family and friends; a good place would be on social media. When you receive Action Corps emails, open them. If the email is asking you to take action, PLEASE do so. Your voice matters!

Again, the first 100 members to take this challenge, the All-American Club will hold the drawing at the next conference or Convention when the 100th Member is entered the contest.


