VA Benefit Payment Rates Increase

The Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) for VA disability compensation benefits program has an 8.7% increase for calendar year 2023.

You should have noticed an increase in your monthly payments, starting on 1 January 2023. This increase will impact your disability benefits, clothing allowance, Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC), as well as other VA assistance programs. If you do not see any difference in your amount, you should contact our VA Regional Office in Montgomery, Alabama at (800) 827-1000.

If you have questions about applying for VA benefits in general or appealing a VA decision, reach out to the <u>Post Service Officer</u> or an <u>accredited VA</u> <u>Representative.</u>
