On 10 November 1775, the Second
Continental Congress established the
Continental Marines by authorizing the
formation of two battalions. Tun Tavern in
Philadelphia, Pennsylvania is regarded as the
birthplace of the Marine Corps. On 1
November 1921, the 13th Commandant, Major
General Lejeune issued Marine Corps Order
No. 47, Series 1921. This message left its
mark in the hearts and minds of all Marines
and is read every 10 November to all
commands. Traditionally, the first piece of
cake is presented to the oldest Marine
present and the second piece to the youngest
Marine present.
